Synopsis of Seminar:	Abbreviated Biography:

The Challenges of Achieving Economic Justice for People of Color	Rev. Dr. David Jefferson, Esq.
Synopsis of Seminar:	Abbreviated Biography:
This seminar will explain how economic justice in the Black community reflects too much in the way our discourse rests on individual actions versus institutional racism. Dr. Jefferson will illustrate how economic injustice is not the result of Black people's personal failings or their lack of drive, talent, or will. He proposes to demonstrate how fellowship must force those who profess to care about justice for Black people have to reckon with economic justice for Black people during this 21 st century.	Rev. Dr. David Jefferson, Sr. became the third Pastor of Metropolitan Baptist Church in Newark, NJ in February of 1995. He continues to serve today under the anointing of the Holy Spirit with a vision for the church of family ministry and community outreach. Responding to the work of the Holy Spirit, the church has grown to become a 7,000+ member congregation. Like Nehemiah, Pastor Jefferson has been convicted to rebuild the walls of the city of Newark; to uplift Families and restore community. To that end, Pastor Jefferson expanded Metropolitan's physical campus to include what has become known as The Willing Heart Community Care Center, a nonprofit center supported by Heart-to-Heart Partners Covenant.

Synopsis of Seminar:	Abbreviated Biography:
This seminar is most relevant for Pastors and Ministers because normal everyday stressors coupled with the COVID19 pandemic such as restrictions, social distancing and deaths of parishioners have become a major concern for clergy. Clergy not only must deal with their own personal stressors, but they are also interconnected to an entire congregation and many times to the community at large. This seminar will help clergy initiate and take pro-active measures to build personal and organizational resilience during these challenging times. Biblical interpretations and religious rituals will be explored to help Pastors and Ministers cope with stress.	Rev. Ruth Scott along with her husband, Rev. Hosie L. Scott, are the co-founders and co-pastors of Foundational Truth Bible Study Ministries in Freehold, NJ. She completed the ASCPE Chaplain Training at RWJ Hospital in New Brunswick, NJ in 2007. For the past 8 years, she facilitated a Healing Helper Support Group and continued to volunteer as a Chaplain at Bayshore Hospital until COVID19 restrictions occurred in Year 2020. As a licensed associate counselor in New Jersey, she does pastoral counseling and works with community mental health partners. Pastor Scott has an extensive background in facilitating workshops and retreats.
